- 2. Finances/Approval of Bills
 - Grants awarded
 - The Argyle American Legion donated \$300 towards children's STEAM programming. We are currently purchasing some books and will create grabn-go crafts and passive projects in the library with this funding.
 - We were awarded \$1,000 from the UW Center of East Asian studies to use towards materials reflecting Asian authors and culture. I had forgotten that I applied for this 6 months ago so it was a really nice surprise!
 - Still waiting to hear about our Argyle Community Foundation application to improve the library entrance way/ new sign/ bench etc.
 - Wisconsin Humanities Grant is due by Feb. Investigating ideas and would like to apply.
 - Copier purchase
 - I purchased a Lexmark printer for \$1,125 through Gordon Flesch. The library has paid for it, and will be reimbursed through SWLS grant monies. There will be a \$10/monthly maintenance fee. They will remove the old printers, although we have had some interest from other SWLS libraries who may want them.

 - We are part of a pilot program through the DNR where patrons can check out park pass stickers through March 1.
