

## Social Media Policy January 2024

This policy defines acceptable use of social media for authorized Argyle Public Library staff. Social media is defined here as any web-based application, site, software, or other online account, including Flickr, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and other similar outlets. The Library participates in social media to:

- Reach out to participating and prospective patrons
- Promote the value and importance of the services offered,
- Showcase special events, and
- Provide tips for reading skills and language development.

The Library shall engage in the following practices related to social media.

- 1. Make sure multiple people have access to the Library's social media accounts.
- 2. Post content regularly.
- 3. Posts should be respectful, professional in tone, in good taste, and related to the Library's mission.
- 4. Authorized Library personnel must understand that social media is public and permanent. Messages can be read by anyone, and there should be no expectation of privacy.
- 5. Social media websites each have their own terms and conditions/policies, and the Library will adhere to these.
- 6. Titles and messages should be brief but strive to add value. Content should be useful and interesting to the audience. Avoid posting links to other items.
- 7. Always check facts, spelling, and grammar. Cite sources and do not use copyrighted images.
- 8. Post between one and five times per week.
- 9. Ask questions in posts to engage readers.
- 10. Monitor the page and keep up with the conversation.
- 11. Be aware of the difference between internal and external communications. Never post sensitive information.

- 12. Do not post things that are obscene, racist, derogatory, libelous or otherwise offensive. Do not post personal attacks, insults, threatening language, commercial promotions, or spam.
- 13. The Library will accept friend/follower requests from anyone except users who have violated the site's policies or who post inflammatory, offensive, or exploitative materials.
- 14. The Library reserves the right to remove any posts or comments.
- 15. The Library is not responsible for or liable for content posted by users. User comments do not represent the opinions or positions of the Library.
